



SCICU Excellence in Teaching Awards

Program Guidelines

1. There will be one SCICU Excellence in Teaching award per institution for an undergraduate faculty member who exemplifies the qualities and skills most desired for enabling student learning.
2. Each institution is free to select a recipient according to the institution's practices and policies. The award will be provided to an undergraduate faculty member for professional development, not as a monetary award, stipend, or any disbursement that would be deemed as taxable income. More than one person or unit (for example, academic department) may share in the professional development money, but there will be one named recipient per institution.
3. A certificate will be presented to each recipient at a dinner honoring the twenty SCICU member institution award winners. Award recipients and senior officials are expected to attend the awards dinner. Each college/university will be provided a table that will accommodate eight (8) seats.

CLTE Innovations in Teaching Grants

Program Guidelines

1. Multiple CLTE Innovations in Teaching grants may be awarded each Spring, as funding allows.
2. All fulltime graduate and undergraduate faculty are eligible to apply.
3. Funds are not meant to be used for course buy-outs or teaching release time, but may be used for equipment, materials, research or program development that support innovative practice in teaching and learning.
4. Faculty who apply for, but are not selected for the SCICU Excellence in Teaching Award, may automatically be considered for a CLTE Innovations in Teaching Grant.

Applications for either award are due to the Director of the CLTE by February 1st.

Selection Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated by the following criteria:

1. *Impact* on current and future students
2. *Need* of existing programs
3. *Alignment* with strategic goals
4. *Feasibility* of project reaching goals
5. *Sustainability* of project in relation to budget needs
