Eligibility:	all faculty
Incentive type:	funding
Incentive amount:	varies
Purpose:	travel/memberships/development
Deadline:	as needed
Administered by:	College/School Deans

2. FDC Applications	
Eligibility:	Professional Path and Tenure Track Faculty
Incentive type:	funding
Incentive amount:	up to \$1250, repeatable as funding permits
Purpose:	travel for research - 1 <sup>st</sup> priority: dissemination - 2 <sup>nd</sup> priority: ongoing scholarship projects
Deadline:	monthly
Administered by:	Faculty Development Committee

3. Summer Research Stipends	
Eligibility:	Professional Path and Tenure Track Faculty
Incentive type:	funding
Incentive amount:	up to \$1250
Purpose:	Any ongoing scholarship project needs: travel expenses, materials, equipment, residency fees, etc.
Deadline:	May 1
Administered by:	Faculty Development Committee

4. Student Research Initiative		
Eligibility:	undergraduate students	Professional Path and Tenure Track Faculty
Incentive type:	funding	compensation
Incentive amount:	up to \$1000	1 hr. of load pay, based on rate for faculty rank
Purpose:	research needs / travel relate	ed to research
Deadline:	Feb. 1	
Administered by:	Faculty Development Committee	College/School Deans

5. SCICU Excellence in Teaching Award project grant	
Eligibility:	All Undergraduate Faculty
Incentive type:	grant stipend and award
Incentive amount:	\$3000
Purpose:	to fund a project to develop and promote and student learning
Deadline:	Feb. 1
Administered by:	Center for Learning & Teaching Excellence and Selection Committee

6. CLTE Innovations in Teaching mini-grant	
Eligibility:	All Faculty (Undergraduate and Graduate)
Incentive type:	grant stipend
Incentive amount:	varies based on need and available funding
Purpose:	to fund projects to develop and promote and student learning
Deadline:	Feb. 1
Administered by:	Center for Learning & Teaching Excellence and Selection Committee

7. Faculty Scholar Development Program	
Eligibility:	Professional Path and Tenure Track Faculty
Incentive type:	release time and stipend
Incentive amount:	½ time teaching load, release from any committee service, 3-credit overload
Purpose:	to provide focused time for scholarship of greater significance
Deadline:	Nov. 1
Administered by:	Center for Learning & Teaching Excellence and Faculty Development Committee

8. CIDL Design and Development Seminar Series (Fall and Spring)	
Eligibility:	All Faculty
Incentive type:	compensation
Incentive amount:	\$500 - \$1000
Purpose:	To design/redesign course for online delivery, use of open educational resources, or new Gold Core Curriculum offerings
Deadline:	Early Fall; Early Spring
Administered by:	Center for Innovation & Digital Learning

Eligibility:	All Faculty
Incentive type:	compensation
Incentive amount:	\$500 - \$1000
Purpose:	To design/redesign course for online delivery, use of open educational resources, or new Gold Core Curriculum offerings
